

OUT NOW FOR WINDOWS & MACOS

ParkShelf gives Windows and Mac the “I’ll need that later” button they never had

A new native desktop utility for Windows and Mac lets you *park* any open window onto a tiny shelf — out of your taskbar, Dock and app switcher — and bring it back the instant you need it. Free to start.

SYDNEY, Australia — 26 June 2026 — Digital x Design today released **ParkShelf**, a native desktop utility that gives people a fast, deliberate way to set aside the windows they will need later without losing track of them. Available now for Windows (x64 and Arm) and macOS, ParkShelf lets you drag any open window — or use a global hotkey — to “park” it on a small shelf, removing it from the taskbar, Dock and app switcher until a single click brings it back exactly where you left it.

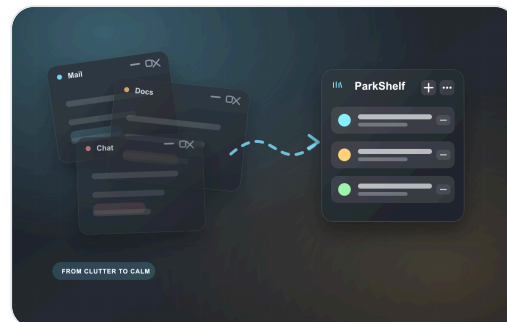
Desktops fill up fast: the reference doc, the half-read article, the chat window you keep drifting back to. Minimising buries them in a crowded taskbar or Dock; closing loses your place. ParkShelf adds the move that was missing — a holding pen that keeps a window one click away while it stays out of sight and out of mind. Parked windows keep running; only the clutter disappears.

A preview lets you check a window before restoring it, and when ParkShelf is idle the shelf collapses to a tiny puck with a count badge, so the tool itself never becomes clutter. A local recovery ledger restores parked windows automatically if the app or the computer restarts.

“This app was created to fill what I have long seen as a gap in the user experience. I think of it as a ‘visual minimiser’ that helps clear space on my desktop quickly when I need it, and helps me quickly get back into the flow again.”

ParkShelf is free for up to three windows parked at once, with every core feature included. A one-time Pro upgrade (**US\$6.99**) unlocks unlimited parked windows on both macOS and Windows; a single Windows licence covers the x64 and Arm builds. ParkShelf is built to stay out of the way in every sense: no telemetry, no analytics and no background network calls, with settings kept in a local file.
